The Lucerne Festival, the Conference of Swiss Institutions for Higher Education in Music and the Credit Suisse Jubilee Foundation have jointly established a CHF 25,000 prize with the aim of promoting highly talented musicians in Switzerland.

The Credit Suisse Jubilee Foundation provides the financial backing while the Lucerne Festival and the Conference of Swiss Institutions for Higher Education in Music contribute their expertise and organize the venues for the performances. The Conference of Swiss Institutions for Higher Education in Music is also responsible for coordinating and holding the auditions.

The musicians are nominated by the Conference of Swiss Institutions for Higher Education in Music. Direct applications are not possible. A maximum of five candidates are admitted. The age limit for participants is generally 26 years. The panel's decision is based on an absolute majority in favor of one candidate.

The 2007 prize winner, Aniela Frey (flute), appeared as a soloist with the Vienna Philharmonic on August 21, 2007 at the "Lucerne Festival, Sommer".
