

# Credit Suisse Foundation in Switzerland

## Background

The Jubilee Foundation was established in 1981 to mark the Bank's 125th anniversary. In 1998, it merged with the Jubilee Foundation of Swiss Volksbank, which was founded in 1969. In 2008, the Jubilee Foundation was integrated into the Credit Suisse Foundation under the name "Jubilee Fund of the Credit Suisse Foundation".

The Credit Suisse Foundation, domiciled in Zurich, is a charitable foundation pursuant to Art. 80ff of the Swiss Civil Code and is supervised by the Federal Supervisory Board for Foundations (Federal Department of Home Affairs). Since 2009, the Jubilee Fund of the Credit Suisse Foundation has been a member of SwissFoundations, the Association of Swiss grant-making Foundations.

It builds on the foundation of collaboration with the Swiss Youth Music Competition Foundation, goes on to the Prix Credit Suisse Jeunes Solistes, and peaks with the presentation of the Credit Suisse Young Artist Award.

We also make an important contribution to the quality of academic teaching within the university and scientific fields with the Credit Suisse Award for Best Teaching. Swiss universities, technical universities, and universities of applied sciences are given the opportunity to present the award to outstanding teachers and teams. For the Credit Suisse Foundation, the decisive criterion for the selection of the winner is the special, innovative, creative, efficient, and effective type of knowledge transfer. The procedure and nomination are the sole responsibility of the universities.
