Museum Haus Konstruktiv. Facts.

The Museum Haus Konstruktiv art and design museum is supported by the Foundation for Constructivist, Concrete and Conceptual Art (Stiftung für konstruktive, konkrete und konzeptuelle Kunst), which was founded in 1986 by a dedicated group of individuals associated with the internationally important Zurich movement in constructivist and concrete art.

The foundation is based in Zurich (Canton of Zurich).



Objectives

The Museum Haus Konstruktiv art and design museum is the leading institution for constructivist-concrete and conceptual art in Switzerland. The museum has made it its task to keep this art-historical heritage alive and to link it to contemporary art. Another important element is art education for children and young people; the aim is to introduce them to the world of art in a fun way.

Kinderkulturakademie Zürich (KKAZ)

The Kinderkulturakademie Zürich KKAZ (Children's Cultural Academy Zurich) is an interdisciplinary cultural education project run by the Museum Haus Konstruktiv for children and young people. A KKAZ semester is held on several afternoons in various Zurich cultural institutions that change from semester to semester. Each KKAZ semester also addresses a different topic. At the different KKAZ events, the children take a look behind the scenes at different cultural institutions and experiment in the artistic disciplines of music, theater, fine art, and dance, while developing their own works of art. At the end of the semester course, the children receive a personal KKAZ diploma. Approximately 60 children take part in the KKAZ program every year. Thanks to the Credit Suisse Foundation's contribution, around one-third of the places go to children and young people from low-income families.
