Background

The Stiftung go tec! Schaffhausen (go tec! foundation Schaffhausen) was founded in 2013; its aim is to make mathematics, IT, natural sciences, and especially technology (STEM subjects) accessible to a broad target group.

The foundation is based in Schaffhausen (Canton of Schaffhausen).



Objectives

When technology that is often invisible in everyday life is made comprehensible to students, this fascinates children and young people and helps them to understand precisely this technology. The new curriculum, Lehrplan 21, addresses the need for additional technical skills and reinforces the STEM subjects at a young age to equip children for the future. go tec! helps teachers to implement the corresponding learning objectives through expertise and resources that they can access both in their classrooms and in the go tec! laboratory in Neuhausen am Rheinfall.

Internet and code for girls

The program "Internet and code for girls" will enable girls to engage with the topic "coding and programming" with the help of female role models (generally female students at EPFL, the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Lausanne). They not only learn how to compile information and turn it into digital format, but are also made aware of the pitfalls and risks lurking on the internet. After completing the course successfully, the participants receive their certificate at a special ceremony attended by family and friends. The project comprises courses on 11 Saturdays for up to 40 girls.
