Credit Suisse Philanthropy Partners in India



Buddy4Study India Foundation

Buddy4Study is India's largest scholarship platform making education affordable. Buddy4Study also provides training materials and mentorship to scholars.

Credit Suisse supports a merit-based scholarship program providing financial assistance to more than 400 young people from low-income families studying at selected MBA and engineering colleges in India over three years.

Ecosan Services Foundation (ESF)

ESF works in the field of sustainable sanitation. ESF has gained extensive experience in capacity development, policy building, awareness raising, project implementation and consulting in the field of sustainable sanitation.

Credit Suisse supports sanitation initiatives to improve awareness on sanitation and access to toilets in

schools for low-income communities, impacting 30,000 students in 32 schools over four years.

Eyebetes Foundation

Eyebetes Foundation is a not-for-profit working towards diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation of patients suffering from preventable causes of blindness like glaucoma, diabetes, aging, cataract, and surface diseases.

Credit Suisse supported a medical camp in slum around Powai, with a population of more than 50,000 people, where individuals received a free blood test for thyroid, lipids, and diabetes. Individuals underwent an eye exam by professionals and received spectacles as a result. Following this, they had screening for preventable causes of blindness, and experts examined the results. 2000 individuals were tested during this camp

Generation India Foundation (GIF)

GIF transform education to employment systems to prepare, place, and support people into life-changing careers that would otherwise be inaccessible.

Credit Suisse supports a project that trains and supports close to 1,000 disconnected youths in Covid-resilient job roles with high employment outcomes in Pune and Mumbai over two years.

Give India Foundation & Masina Hospital Trust

Give India enables individuals and organizations to raise and donate funds conveniently for any causes they care about, including crowdfunding, corporate giving, cause marketing, and philanthropy consulting.

Masina Hospital is a multi-specialty hospital set up in Byculla, Mumbai offering primary, secondary, and tertiary solutions in healthcare.

Credit Suisse supports the Masina Hospital through Give India Foundation to set up 8 outpatient departments and state-of-the-art diagnostic pathology laboratory that will include Hematology, Serum Biochemistry, Microbiology and Histopathology departments.

Green Yatra Trust

Green Yatra is a leading environmental NGO dedicated towards protection, conservation and betterment of Mother Nature and Humanity. It was established in 2010 and is currently working PAN India in major metro cities specializing in urban forest initiatives.

Credit Suisse is supporting Miyawaki plantation & has committed to plant more than 50,000 saplings across Pune & Mumbai.

iTeach Schools

iTeach Schools works to address the high drop-out rate for the poorest of India's students by starting a chain of affordable secondary schools.

Credit Suisse supports secondary school education in three schools in Pune, impacting 2,000 students and 200 teachers over three years.

Jai Vakeel Foundation

Jai Vakeel Foundation provides a holistic approach to the management of individuals with intellectual disability.

Credit Suisse supports vocational training, livelihood opportunities and support for daily living for more than 200 students with Intellectual & Development Disabilities to enable them to engage productively in their families and wider community.

Lend A Hand India

Lend-A-Hand India partners with local governments in 23 states to provide them with technical and project management support to scale up vocational education.

Credit Suisse supports the introduction of a vocational training module on the basics of finance for students in grades 9–10. As part of this curriculum, 9,000 students will be provided with internship opportunities in the finance and accounting sector during their 11th and 12th grade over four years.

Lighthouse Communities Foundation

Lighthouse communities Foundation formerly known as Pune City Connect works toward creating a shift of 'working to survive mindset' in the urban slum young people, addressing the issue of motivated skilled workforce for the city of Pune.

Credit Suisse supports three Lighthouse Skilling Centers in Pune that provide various skilling programs to more than 7000 disadvantaged young people and enable them to find jobs over three years.

Magic Bus Foundation

Magic Bus trains children and young people through activity-based learning and focuses on life skills, soft skills and resilience to ensure they have the right employability skills.

Credit Suisse supports one skills training and job placement center in Mumbai for training more than 800 young people aged 18-25 years old, preparing them for jobs in the retail, ITES, QSR (Quick Service Restaurants) and finance sectors over three years.

Mann Deshi Foundation

Mann Deshi Foundation provides women with the knowledge, skills and support necessary to become successful entrepreneurs.

Credit Suisse supports a project that will provide financial literacy training and offers doorstep saving products to over 8,000 women in remote rural locations over a period of three years.

Muktangan Education Trust

Muktangan provides an alternative schooling program run in government schools that aims to bridge prevalent gaps in education by providing an inclusive, student-friendly, community-based model of education within the mainstream system.

Credit Suisse supports the education of over 500 students every year and capacity building of teachers at the Love Grove School for three years.

Sarthak Educational Trust

Sarthak Educational Trust is working towards the employment of people with disabilities.

Credit Suisse supports construction of a Global Resource Center in Gurgaon and one skilling center for close to 1,000 persons with disabilities in IT, retail, and hospitality sectors over three years in Pune.

Society for Nutrition, Education and Health Action (SNEHA)

SNEHA works to improve health and nutrition of women, adolescents and children living in the most vulnerable urban slum settlements. They run projects

on palliative care and nurse aide skilling. They operate across seven municipal corporations of the Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR); and work in partnership with other organizations across various states of India.

Credit Suisse supports 2 skilling centers in Mumbai for more than 700 young women between 18 to 36 years through Swasthya Sevika Nurse Aide training program over three years.

Ummeed Child Development Center

Ummeed is a non-profit organization based in Mumbai, working for children with, and at risk of, developmental disabilities. Seen as a center of excellence and influence in Mumbai and overseas.

Credit Suisse supports setting up of a Family resource Centre for early recognition of and intervention for mental health issues in more than 3,000 families – in turn leading to better outcomes for the child with disability
