### Credit Suisse Asset Management launches Credit Suisse (Lux) Global Digital Health Equity Fund

Zurich, November 20, 2017 **Credit Suisse Asset Management today announces the start of the subscription period for the new Credit Suisse (Lux) Global Digital Health Equity Fund, an innovative equity fund on the theme of digital health.**

The fund comprises a series of thematic equity investments from Credit Suisse that address resilient, long-term trends and make them accessible to investors. The digital health fund concept is based on the realization that digitalization signals a revolution for the healthcare sector. It has the potential to significantly improve the quality of medical services, and also to curb rising healthcare costs. With expected growth of 15% per year, digital health is one of the fastest-growing segments of the healthcare industry.

The focus is on the three sub-divisions of research and development, innovative treatments, and efficiency improvements. The objective is to find solid SME stocks that are able to bring to market innovative products with major commercial potential and to generate at least 50% of their revenues from digital health – pure players, in other words.

The result is a focused pure-play equity fund that targets one of the fastest-growing and most innovative areas of investment. The Luxembourg-domiciled fund is UCITS-compliant and will offer daily liquidity. The subscription period starts today and runs until December 13, 2017.

Other thematic funds from Credit Suisse Asset Management address the areas of robotics, safety & security, and infrastructure.
