Notice is hereby given to the Unitholders of **CS Investment Funds 11 – Credit Suisse (Lux) Small and Mid Cap Europe Equity Fund** (for the purpose of this point the “**Subfund**”) that the Board of Directors of the Management Company has decided to amend the Investment Objective and Policy of the Subfund as follows:

Old Investment Objective and Policy	New Investment Objective and Policy
<p>At least two-thirds of this Subfund’s assets are invested in small and medium-sized European companies. The investment region of Europe shall include all EU and EFTA countries. Small and medium-sized companies are defined as all companies with a market capitalization of less than 5 billion Euros at the time the investment is made.</p> <p>Furthermore, the Subfund may invest up to one-third of its assets in other equities and equity-type securities, subject to the investment restrictions set out in Chapter 6, “Investment Restrictions”.</p>	<p>At least two-thirds of this Subfund’s assets are invested in small and medium-sized European companies. The investment region of Europe shall include all EU and EFTA countries. Small and medium-sized companies are defined as all companies which are not contained in the EURO STOXX 50 Index.</p> <p>Furthermore, the Subfund may invest up to one-third of its assets in other equities and equity-type securities, subject to the investment restrictions set out in Chapter 6, “Investment Restrictions”.</p> <p>The Subfund will invest at least 51% of its total net assets in Qualifying Equity Instruments.</p>

Unitholders who do not agree with this change can redeem their units free of charge until 04.06.2018 3 p.m. CET. The above change will enter into effect on 05.06.2018.
