

Tea Bags



Tip

Put the tea bags for sale in a see-through bag or hand-folded box.

What you need

- Tea bags with string
- Thick paper
- Colored markers
- Stickers

Instructions

- ① Fold the paper and cut a shape starting from the edge. That way, you will get an identical front and back. You can also take a pencil and trace round an object on the paper, and cut the shape out twice. Color both sides, and let them dry.
- ② Remove the original paper from the tea bags, and glue the string between your new front and back pieces.



BALLS

Tip

You will be sure to impress your customers if you juggle the balls.

What you need

- Balloons
- Sawdust and sand (from the pet store)
Tip: This also works with rice.
- See-through bags

Tip

For patterns, cut small holes in the individual balloon layers, or make stripes that you pull over the bags.



① Mix two handfuls of sawdust and sand, fill a see-through bag with it, and tie a tight knot. Cut off the remaining plastic above the knot.



② Take between two and four balloons of different colors, and cut the necks of the balloons off.



③ Pull the balloons over each filled bag one at a time.

CUP-AND-BALL GAME



Tip

The bigger the mouth of the cup and the size of ball, the easier the game is to play.

What you need

- Toilet paper roll
- Stapler
- String
- Ball (wooden bead, cork, or similar object)
- Colored markers
- Wiggly eyes
- Strips of adhesive or masking tape

Instructions

- ① Staple one side of the toilet paper roll together.
- ② Cut off a piece of string, and attach one end of it to the ball. Attach the other end to the cup.
- ③ Color and decorate the cup and ball however you like. You can glue things like ears, teeth, or a mustache around the opening of the cup.
- ④ Now, catch the ball with the cup. Have fun!

Tip

You can also use plastic bottles to make cups. Just cut them in the middle.

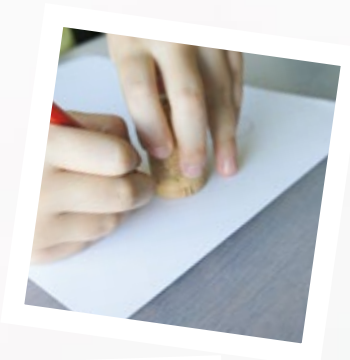
What you need

- One champagne cork for each stamp
- Paper, pen, scissors
- Foam rubber, 2–3 mm thick
- Glue
- Ink pads



Stamp Your LABELS

Instructions



① Place the champagne cork on a sheet of paper, and trace round it with a pencil so you know how big your stamp can be. Make as many circles as the number of stamps you need.



② Draw your shape, letter, or number inside the circle, and cut it out.



③ Place the shapes on the foam rubber, trace round them, and cut them out.



④ Glue them to the cork, and stamp away!



Tip

Star = 1 franc
Moon = 3 francs
