Contactless Payment: It's Really Easy!

We call this the **contactless function** – and you will be able to activate it once you receive your Maestro card. It's really easy: Make a payment or withdraw cash by inserting your card in **a payment terminal or an ATM** and **entering your PIN**. After that, you will be able to make contactless payments with your card – without your PIN for amounts up to CHF 40. The personal daily and monthly limits also apply for contactless payment.

Just Hold to Pay:



Wherever you see this symbol, paying with your Maestro card is even easier.



Take a close look at the amount you are going to pay.



To pay, simply hold your card in front of the reader. Up to CHF 40, no PIN is needed.



In seconds, you will see that you have paid.



PIN stands for Personal Identification Number; in other words, your password. This is a four- to six-digit number combination that we will send to your parents separately. You can change it at ATMs to remember it more easily. This guarantees that only you can use your card. So don't tell your PIN to anyone, except your parents.
