## Pre-condition for Verification

The electronic signature can be verified only with **Acrobat Reader 8.0** and higher.

In addition, you require a **public key**.

Download the Public Key from our internet site [www.credit-suisse.com/edocuments](http://www.credit-suisse.com/edocuments) under the section download Public Key.

## Install the Certificate as follow:

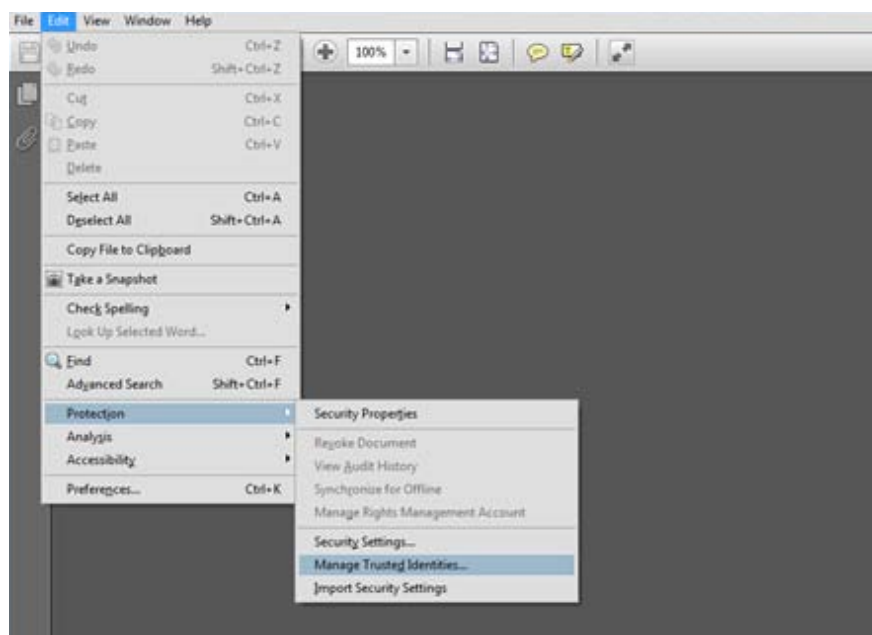

Click under menu "Edit" → "Protection" → "Manage Trusted Identities"



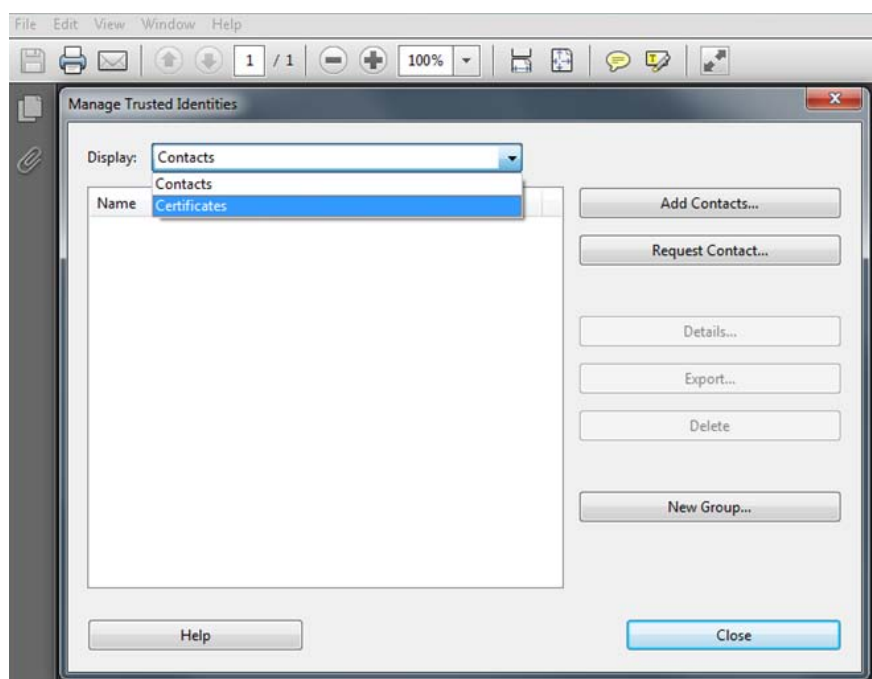

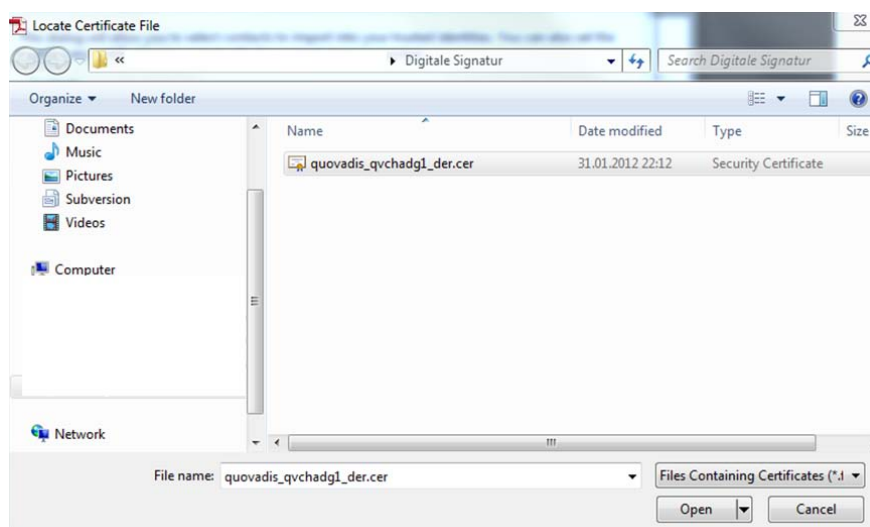
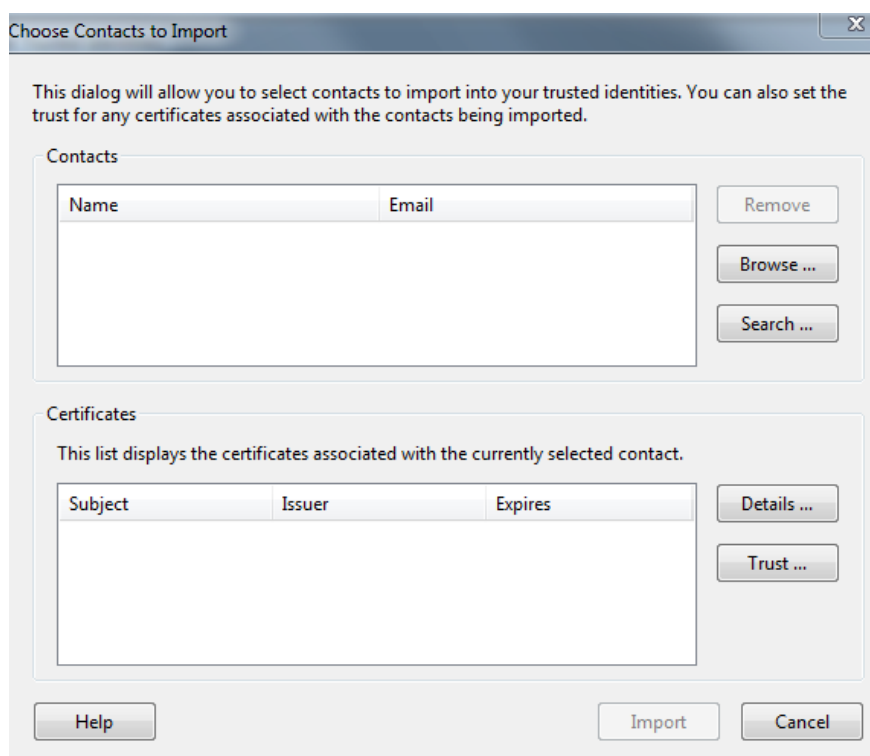
Under "Display" menu item, switch from "Contacts" to "Certificates" and click on "Add Contacts"

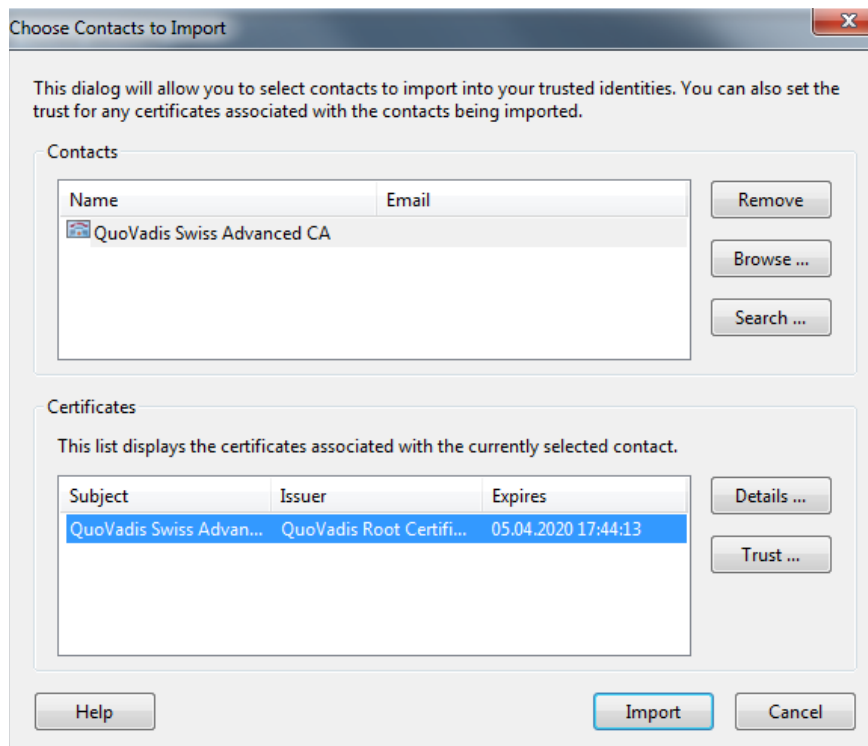




Click on “ QuoVadis ...”, under “Contacts”.

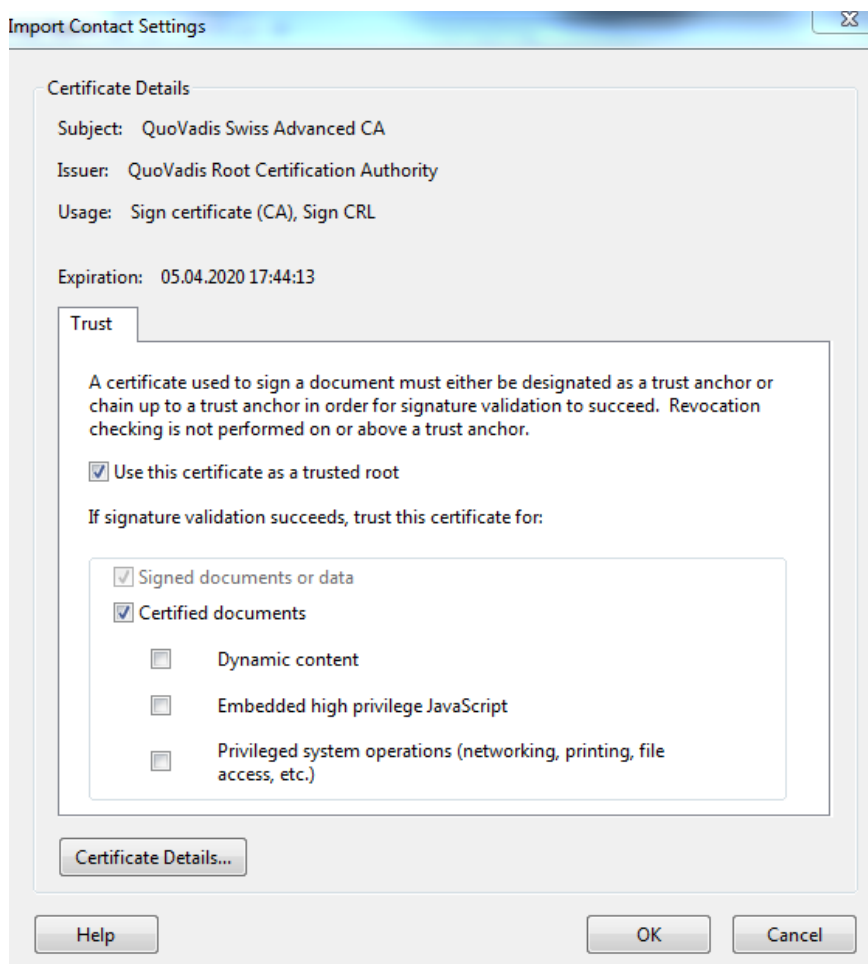
Under “Certificates”, you can now see “QuoVadis” → click on it → click on “Trust...”

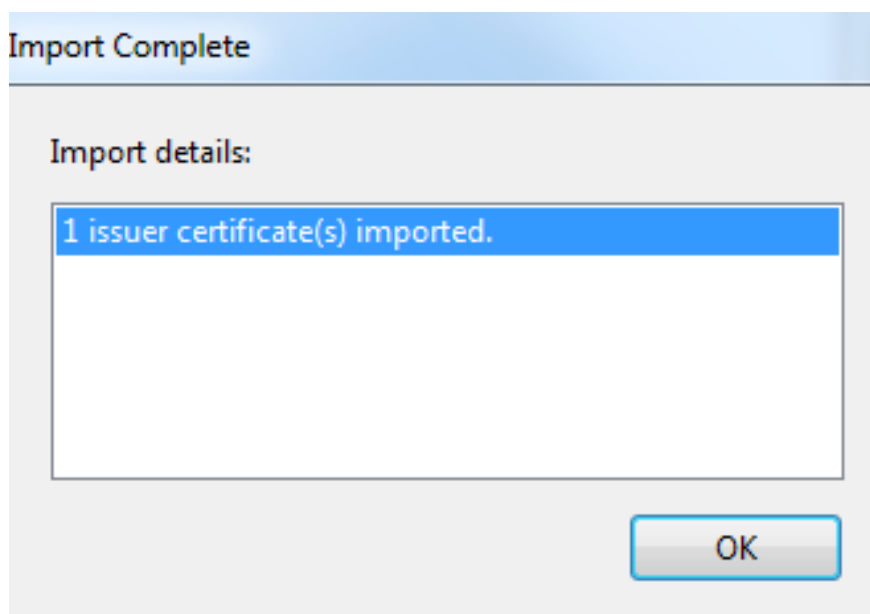
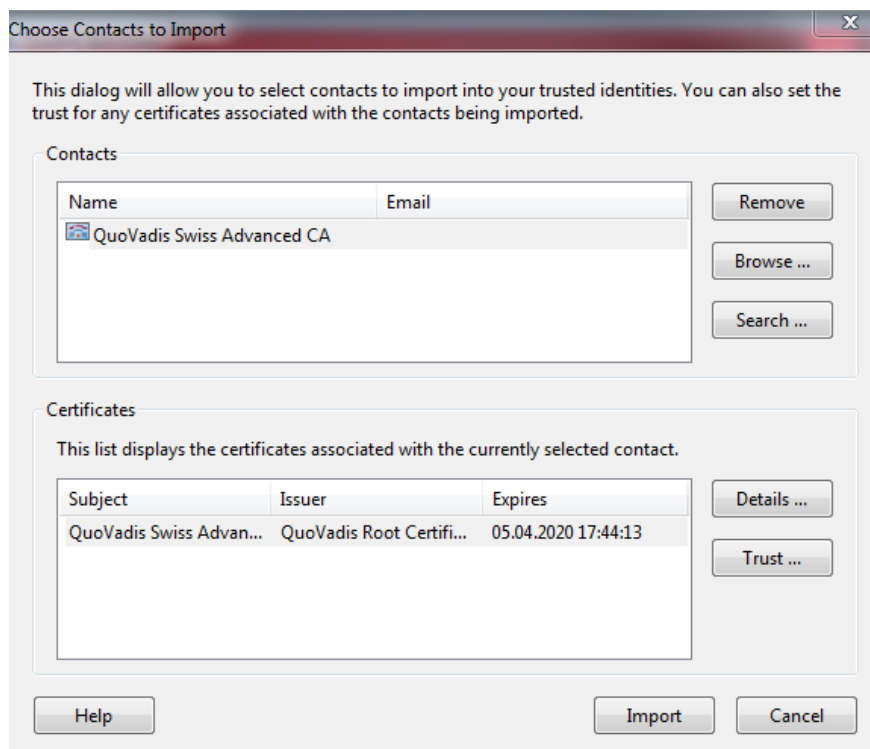

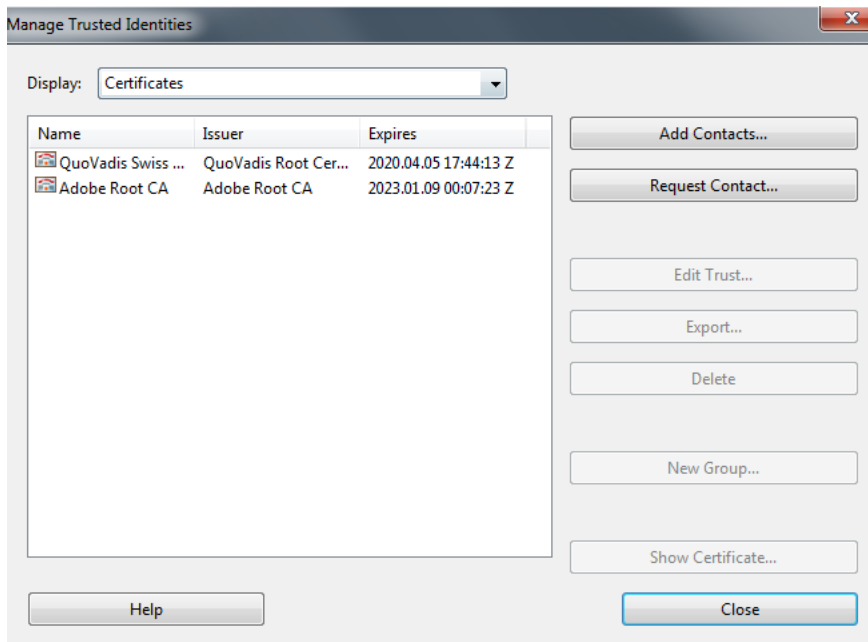


Mark the checkboxes “Use this certificate as a trusted root” and “Certified documents” and click on “OK”

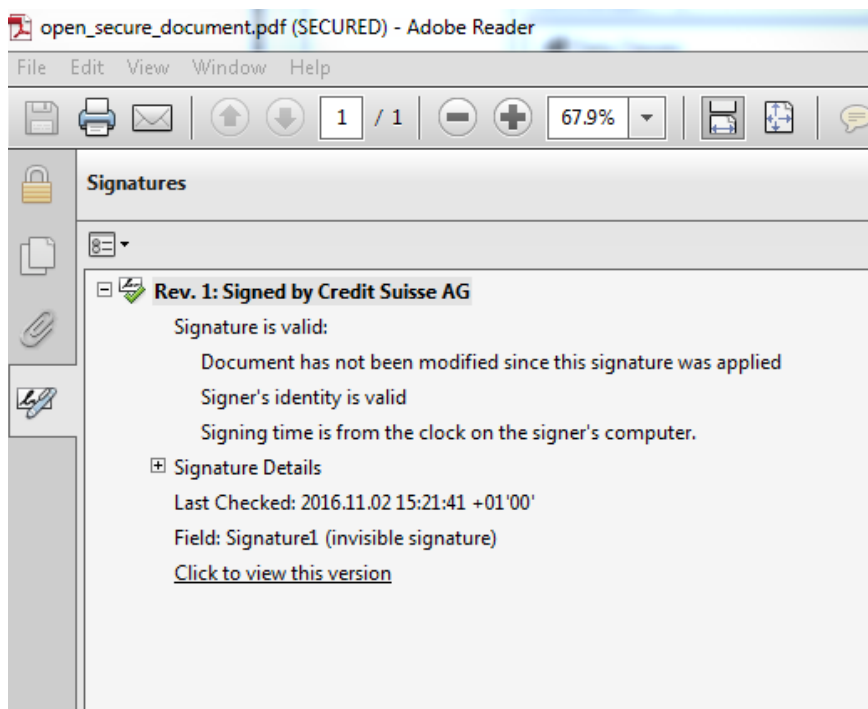






### Verifying the Signature
